Suggestions for clothing to all participants in evangelistic worship services

Recommendations for Participation in Church Services and Worship:

- 1. Please arrive a minimum of 10 minutes before the service is set to begin.
- As you are participating in a worship experience, chose colors that are not striking (distracting). Color recommendations include basic black, white, blue, brown, simple pastel colors and appropriate floral designs.

For Men

- 1. 31 and Over: Wear modest full suits with tie.
- 2. 30 and Under: Wear a tie or jacket if not in full suit.
- 3. Avoid clothing that will distract from the focus of the service.
- 4. Avoid tight fitting clothing.
- 5. Limit extravagant designs.
- 6. Wear clean shoes.
- 7. Ensure hair is properly groomed.

Examples of Men Attire:



For Women

- 1. Choose clothing so that the attention focuses on the service, not on you.
- 2. Avoid tight fitting/transparent clothing or clothing with openings.
- 3. Wear skirts or dress/blouse with sleeves (or wear a shawl or jacket).
- 4. Be careful not to wear very short or low-cut clothing.
- 5. Be careful when sitting down. Avoid crossing your legs while on the platform.
- 6. If you wear make-up, be discreet or modest in application.
